## Re: Conditional Water Licence C055987 on Dalton Spring

The information we have received in our office indicates that you are the new owner of BLOCK A DISTRICT LOT 2557 GROUP 1 NEW WESTMINSTER DISTRICT (PID **017-133-432**).

Water licenses are appurtenant to the land, mine or undertaking, and pass with the conveyance or other disposition of the land to any new owner. We have therefore transferred the water licence into your name. A copy of the licence and plan are enclosed for your records. Please note that it is not our policy to amend the face of the licence to reflect the new owner's name.

The above-mentioned water licence authorizes 500 gallons a day for domestic purpose on that land.

Our Revenue office in Victoria will be contacting you directly with regards to any outstanding water payments. If you have not owned the property all the years during which the monies owing have accumulated, then recovery of your rental payment is a matter to be resolved between yourself and the former owner.

A brochure on Water Rights in British Columbia has been included for your records.

If you do not require the use of water from this source you may choose to abandon the water licence under Section 24 of the *Water Act* by advising our office in writing.

## THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA—WATER ACT

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Dalton D. Schrank of 936 London Place, New Westminster, B.C. V3M 4Z6

is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows.

- (a) The source of the water-supply is Dalton Spring.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 8th January, 1976.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is domestic.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 500 gallons a day, and such additional quantity as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
  - (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A of Lot 2557, Group 1, New Westminster District.
  - (h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structure, pump, tanks and pipe, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
  - (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water shall be beneficially used on or before the 31st day of December, 1982.
  - (j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
